

TRAP SHOOTING RULES

1. No shooting from further than 27 yard line or closer than the 16 yard line.
2. Always point gun down range when on the line.
3. Load only one shell at a time, unless shooting doubles.
4. Load shotgun on the line.
5. Breach open – when walking between posts.
6. Shooters shouldn't distract other shooters while on the line.
7. No loud talking while a round is being shot.
8. In case of gun malfunction, shooting will cease while the range officer and the shooter attempt to remedy the problem.
9. Shooters shouldn't pick up shells while rounds are being shot.
10. No muzzle loaders are to be used at the trap range.
11. A.T.A rules will supplement Ceraland rules.

Any violation of safety rules may result in forfeiture of range use privileges.
