

# General CERA Park Rules

1. Personal alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted outside of your campsite. Beverages are available to purchase at The Landing and special CERA events. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages allowed in the Aquatic Center, Miniature Golf Course or at Youth tournaments/events.
2. Pets must be on a leash and attended to at all times. Owners are responsible for clean up and any accidents. Pets are not allowed in the Aquatic Center, Miniature Golf Course, in cabins. Excessive barking or aggressive pets will be asked to be removed from the park. Service animals must be registered.
3. No swimming in the Lake. Fishing is permitted during daylight hours.
4. Children may not be left unattended in the campground or at park facilities without adult supervision. Children must be on their campsite by dark unless accompanied by an adult. Parents are ultimately responsible for their children's behavior.
5. Fireworks are strictly prohibited in the Park.
6. Only standard golf carts are permitted. No ATVs/UTVs. Driver must be 18+ and have a valid driver's license. Golf carts operated after dusk must have lights turned on. Please see the Golf Cart Permit for full usage rules.
7. Firearms are only permitted at the Trap/Skeet Range during posted hours. Air rifles, pellet guns and bow & arrows are firearms. Hunting is prohibited.
8. All boats/kayaks must have a launch permit each day. Only electric trolling motors are permitted. Please see the Launch Permit for full usage rules.
9. Motor vehicles must observe the posted speed limits. Driving or parking is permitted only in designated areas. Motor vehicles must be properly licensed. Vehicles must be operated by persons possessing a valid driver's license. Vehicles may not be operated on walkways.
10. Go-karts must register daily and operate only in designated areas. Please see Go-Kart Permit on our website for full usage rules.
11. CERApass cards and Day Passes are nontransferable. Park privileges may be forfeited by pass-holders who permit the use of their card to unauthorized persons.
12. Bicycle riding is not permitted on walkways. No bike riding after dark. Helmets are recommended. This also applies to scooters, hoverboards, and skateboards.
13. CERA is not responsible for the loss of personal property or personal injury while attending a CERA program, or park and facilities.
14. All Ceraland facilities are non-smoking facilities. Absolutely NO smoking at Youth events.
15. Vending, peddling, or distribution of any merchandise or literature is prohibited.
16. All waste or garbage should be placed in dumpsters.
17. Fires are permitted only in grills and fire rings.
18. Persons displaying objectionable behavior and/or violating the rules of the Park may be removed from the Park by CERA Management. Persons who have been removed from the Park will not be readmitted without the written permission of

# Campground Rules

## General Information

All camping units must check-in at the Registration Office during regular park hours.

You must be 18 or older to register for a campsite.

Under 18 may not camp alone.

One registered camping unit or two tents per campsite.

One family unit per campsite. A camping unit is defined as either a travel trailer, fifth-wheel, motorcoach, pop-up or tent. Each site is equipped and limited to one picnic table and grill or fire ring, unless approved by management.

All CERA facilities are non-smoking facilities.

The campground is intended for recreational family camping only.

Fireworks are prohibited and Alcohol is not permitted outside of your own campsite

## Bathhouses

There are three bathhouses located in the campground. In order to keep them clean, they will be closed daily during various times. Please note that all bathhouses are non-smoking facilities. Pets are strictly restricted from these facilities.

## Campfires

Campfires are allowed in designated areas, grills, fire rings or approved fire containers.

Only wood and charcoal are allowed to be burned. No trash burning is allowed.

Only 1/2 rick of wood is allowed to be stored on a site at one time.

## Check In & Check Out Times

Check in is 2:00pm. Check-out is 12:00pm. Late check-out is available (if the site has not been reserved for that evening) for a \$5 fee and will give campers until 6pm to check out. A CERA staff member must inspect cabin and camper rentals before check-out is complete.

## Dumpstation

Conveniently located at the North end of the campground between 4th and 5th street, the dumpstation provides drive-up service for two units at one time.

Please refrain from disposing of plastic gloves in the system.

Absolutely no gray water dumping on CERA property.

## Emergency

In case of an emergency, please call 911 and notify the Registration Office (812)-377-5849 ext 100 during the day OR Security at (812) 447-4039 after 10pm.

# Campground Rules

## Children

Children may not be left unattended in the campground or at park facilities without adult supervision. Children must be on their campsite by dark unless accompanied by an adult. **ABSOLUTELY NO BIKE RIDING AFTER 10PM.**

Parents are ultimately responsible for their children's behavior.

## Guests

Any guests visiting the campgrounds that do not have a CERApas will be charged the Parking rate upon entrance to the Park.

No guests will be allowed entry to the Park after 10:00pm.

Guests are welcome to stay all day, but must leave the park by 10:00pm.

Please remember that there is a limit of 2 parked vehicles per site.

## Campstore

CERA has various fishing supplies, camping necessities, RV & tent accessories, and CERA gear located in the Campstore at the CERA Sports building.

## Internet Access

Free wireless access is available throughout the park.

Please note that the internet is intended for web browsing, checking emails, and other low bandwidth activities. Gaming, video streaming, and other high bandwidth usage is available for an additional fee.

## Laundry Facility

The laundry facility, located at the bathhouse at the North end of 2nd and 3rd street, is equipped with 2 washers and 4 dryers. All machines are coin operated and available on a first-come, first serve basis.

Please be considerate and remove clothes immediately.

Laundering pet items is prohibited.

## Long Term & General Camping

Campsites must be neat and clean at all times. No permanent structures, storage units, swimming pools, or water features allowed.

Campers leaving sites unattended for more than 24 hours, should turn off the water.

Tent camping is not permitted longer than 6 consecutive nights.

## Pets

Pets are not permitted in cabins. Pets must be kept on a leash (maximum of six foot in length) at all times and under your control. You are allowed to have a maximum of **THREE PETS PER CAMPSITE**. Your pet must be attended to at all times and at night must be enclosed in your camping unit. Excessive noise or aggressive animals will not be tolerated. Owners are responsible for any accidents and cleaning up after their pets.

# Campground Rules

## Quiet Hours

Quiet Hours are from 11:00pm – 7:00am. All guests must leave by 10:00pm. You are welcome to sit around your campfire as late as you like, but please turn off all radios and hold down the noise. Do not disturb your neighbors!

## Security

A night security watchman is provided for your convenience from Memorial Day – Halloween from 10:00pm – 5:00am and is located at the Front Gatehouse. Please call (812) 447-4039 for ANY SECURITY issues from 10:00pm – 5:00am.

## Severe Weather Alert

Please be aware of severe weather in the area. Take shelter in the closest bathhouse if you have any fear of the weather becoming violent.

## Trash

Dumpsters are provided at various locations throughout the campground. Trash bags will be provided to you upon request at the Registration Office. Please help keep our park clean!

## Vehicles

Each site is limited to two vehicles per site. Vehicle tags will be given at check-in. This tag is necessary for re-entry to the park. All extra vehicles must park in a designated parking lot but will not be given a car tag. Campground roads must be clear at all times for emergency vehicles to get through. All motorized vehicles (including scooters) must be operated by persons possessing a valid driver's license. Vehicles may not be operated on walkways. Golf Carts must be registered at the Registration Office. No bike, hoverboard, scooter, or skateboard riding on walkways or after 10pm. Helmets are recommended.

## Golf Carts

Golf carts must be registered at the Registration Office. Only standard golf carts permitted, **no ATV's, side by side's, or UTV's**. Driver must be 18+ and have a valid driver's license. Golf carts operated after dusk must have front and rear lights. No carts may be used during quiet hours except for travel to the bathhouses. Carts are to be operated properly and remain on roadways. Golf carts are not permitted on Go Kart track or on Ball Diamonds. Horseplay, off-road riding, racing, speeding, or other misuse will not be tolerated and will result in loss of permit without refund. Limit of 4 passengers and all passengers must remain seated. It is unlawful to operate the cart while drinking or under the influence. Anyone found abusing the rules will forfeit operating privileges.
